ELIGIBILITY

- This is a multi-club competition open to swimmers currently registered with Swimming Canada or a World Aquatics affiliated year-round club. No-Time (NT) entries will not be accepted. Entries will be limited to a maximum of 500 swimmers with a minimum 200 swimmers required to proceed with the meet. Meet Management reserves the right to modify the minimum and maximum number of entries as required.
- No-Time (NT) entries will not be accepted.

Meet Management reserves the right to alter, revise, limit enrolment, or otherwise modify the program to ensure maximum number of swims in a session of reasonable length. Coaches will be notified of any changes prior to the meet.

AGE GROUPS

- Individual events: 10&Under, 11-12, 13-14, 15&Over (both genders).
**Swimmers age will be determined as of the first day of the meet*
- 400 Free, 400 IM and 800 Free events will be 12&U, 13&O

FORMAT

- All sessions will consist of timed finals for all age groups.
- All timed finals will be swum slowest to fastest.
- Adjacent warm-up/cool down lanes will be provided during all sessions
- 400 Free, 400 IM and 800 Free may be restricted by the number of heats created.
***Positive check-in will be required and due by the start of each session.**

ENTRIES

ENTRY RULES

- Swimmers are limited to a maximum of 6 individual events, 2 per session.
- All entries must be made using Hy-Tek and submitted through the Swimming Canada online system (www.swimming.ca) before entry deadline.
- Entries with no time (NT) will not be accepted
- Deck entries will be accepted up to 30 minutes prior to the start of each session and will be accepted provided that extra heats are not created. Deck entries are limited to swimmers who have registered for the competition through the Swimming Canada online system. *Deck entries will be considered exhibition swims and will not be scored. Payment for deck entries must be provided at the time of request.
- Entries will be limited to a maximum of 500 swimmers with a minimum of 200 swimmers required to proceed with the meet. Meet management reserves the right to modify the meet program and/or entry numbers to allow for the maximum number of swims within the time allotted as per Swim Alberta's session guidelines. In case of over subscription, preference will be given to Calgary Patriot swimmers first and then to clubs competing on all days.
- Coaches will be advised of any changes to the program via email.

ENTRY DEADLINE

- Entries **due by 12:00 PM on Friday June 5, 2026.**

SCRATCH DEADLINE

- Scratch deadline: **12:00 p.m. on Friday, June 12, 2026.** No refunds provided for scratches received after this date.
- Event day scratches will be accepted up to 30 minutes prior to the start of each session. There will be no penalties for swimmers who 'no show' or submit a late scratch for their event.

MEET GUIDELINES

SAFE SPORT

- All interactions between an athlete and an individual who is in a position of trust should normally and wherever possible, be in an environment or space that is both “open” and “observable” to others.

MEET RULES

- The meet will be conducted under published World Aquatics (WA) and/or WPS rules and regulations supplemented by published and approved Swimming Canada and Swim Alberta rules and regulations. In addition, this meet package shall outline all changes to and specific application of the published rules. Swim Alberta policies and procedures, where appropriate will also apply.
- Swimming Canada competition warm-up safety procedures will be in effect at this meet.
- The Swim Alberta scratch rule will be in effect for this competition.
- Starts will be conducted from Starting Platforms (blocks) as per World Aquatics Facility Rule 16.1.4, 16.1.8 and Swimming Canada’s Swimming Rule 4.1.
- All swimmers are permitted to race in the swimwear of their choosing at all competitions sanctioned by Swim Alberta. It is not required to declare the choice of swimwear to the Referee if the fabric of the swimwear is a permeable open mesh textile and would not reasonably be seen to create a technical advantage in terms of speed, buoyancy, or endurance.

PHOTOGRAPHY/VIDEOGRAPHY

- To minimize risk, all photographs and video taken at Swimming Canada and Swim Alberta sanctioned competitions, whether taken by a professional photographer or videographer, spectator, team support staff or any other participant, must observe generally accepted standards of decency. Under no circumstances are cameras or other recording devices allowed in the area immediately behind the starting blocks during practice or competition starts, or in locker rooms, bathrooms, or any other dressing area.

HOSPITALITY

- Hospitality will be provided throughout the sessions for coaches, volunteers and officials. All individuals should bring their own water bottle and/or coffee cup with a lid to be filled to omit excess waste and prevent spills on deck. As usual, it will be warm on deck so please prepare accordingly.
